This funding will be used to

- Ensure all students are achieving above NMS in literacy and numeracy or have an evidenced-based learning plan in place to address their specific learning needs
- Increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN reading upper two bands from 0% in 2014 to 90% in 2016
- Ensure 90% of prep students will be reading at PM level 9 by the end of 2015
- Ensure 100% of year 2 students will be reading at PM level 25 by the end of 2015

Our strategy will be to

- Embed the practice of daily guided/shared/modelled reading sessions in the P-6 cohort
- Introduce the STARS program for all year levels
- Explicitly teach comprehension strategies to ensure knowledge and understanding (Archer & Hughes, Hollingsworth & Ybarra)
- Provide professional development opportunities designed to develop teacher skills in data analysis (Hattie)

Our school will improve student outcomes by

Purchase STARS student booklets and Teacher Guides to complement CARS program already in place	\$ 720
Purchase 3 laptop computers for Year 2 cohort to utilise programs for literacy and numeracy learning and consolidation	\$3 500
Provide TRS to release teacher/principal to engage in data analysis and the use of data to inform planning and student monitoring – 1 day per semester	\$ 860
